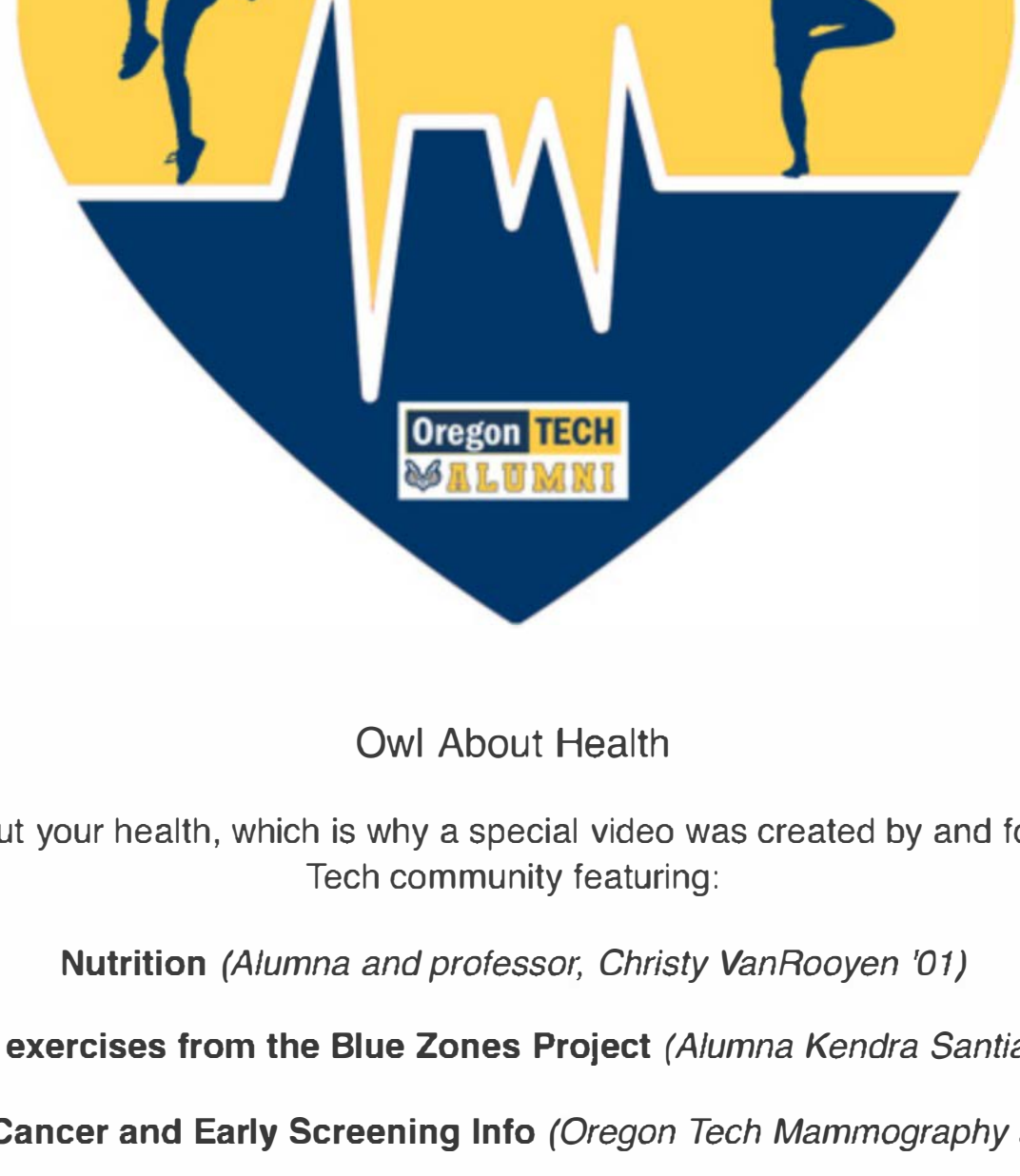


Join us for **THE GOLDEN OWLS REUNION**

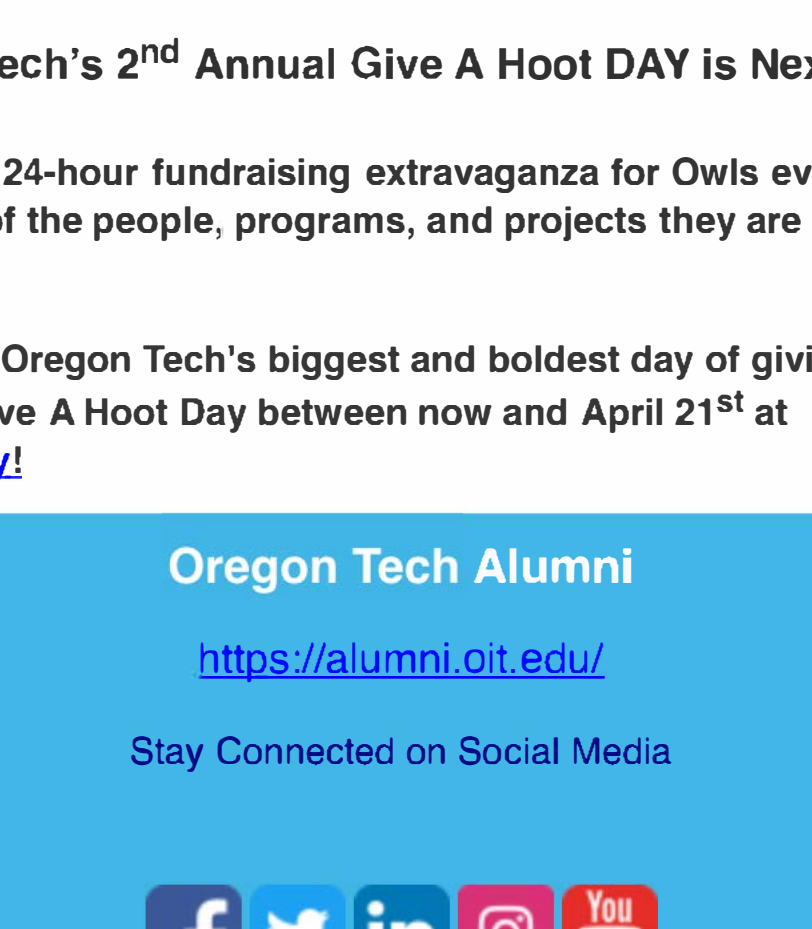

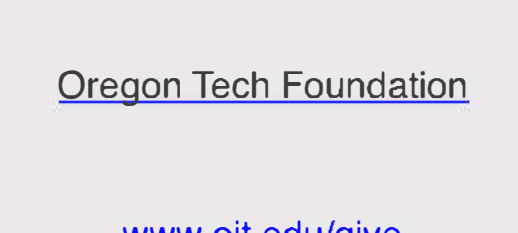


Oregon Tech's 2nd Annual Give A Hoot DAY is Next Month!
